

REMITTANCE BY TOUR OPERATORS / TRAVEL AGENTS TO OVERSEAS AGENTS / PRINCIPALS / HOTELS

Tour Operators / Travel Agents are permitted by RBI to collect Indian Rupees <u>only for surface transportation</u> and this amount can be remitted to the Overseas Agent / Principal / Hotel.

Documents to be verified: -

- 1. Letter from the India based Tour Operator / Travel Agent
- 2. Form A 2 Application cum Declaration
- 3. Overseas Invoice stating amount that needs to be remitted.
- 4. List of passengers with details for whom the transaction is being undertaken
- 5. Draft Application form / SWIFT transfer form, whichever is applicable.

Documents to be kept on record:-

- 1. Form A2 Application cum Declaration
- 2. Letter from the India based Tour operator / Travel Agent
- 3. Copy of Invoice with full details
- 4. Passenger list with full details such as name, passport number, date and place of issue, amount to be remitted, agent's commission etc.

Quantum of Exchange:-

As per the Invoice MINUS the Agents Commission.
